The 5-Key Model is a multi-phase, 4-year research model conducted throughout 7 states with continued expansion. The 5-Key Model for Reentry is a data-driven reentry services approach that provides behavioral health-focused supports for individuals leaving incarceration

- Conducted research assessments over an 18 month period research with 500 participants.
- Conducted research assessments with justice involved participants while adhering to IRB protocol and regulations.
- Met with research participants in community settings to conduct research assessments.
- Assisted with the modification of research design based on clinical findings
